Summer Volunteer Training Class at the Amarillo Zoo

Are you looking for a wild way to help your community, learn new skills, make new friends and have a fun time? The Amarillo Zoo has the answer! On Saturday, June 4 the Zoo is holding its summer volunteer training class for anyone ages 13 and over that would like to become a ZooCrew volunteer. We are looking for individuals who are interested in exciting opportunities to work with our animals, educate our guests and help with special events.

To be eligible to attend the training class you must fill out an application and go through an interview process. You can apply on-line at the Zoo's website www.amarillozoo.org or applications can be picked up in person at the Zoo. Applications must be returned no later than May 28, 2016.

Interviews will be conducted during the following week. For those accepted into the program there will be a \$25 fee to cover the cost of uniform t-shirts and training manual. Volunteers accepted into the program must attend a training class and agree to a minimum of (2) four-hour shifts each month.

The Zoo is especially interested in recruiting college students and retired individuals who might be interested in serving as exhibit interpreters in our education center.
